

Post Flu Vaccine Information

- You must wait 20 minutes in your car after the vaccine is given. You must be rechecked by a medical personnel prior to driving away. ***If you do not complete or follow the protocol you waive all liability risks and are fully responsible for any adverse outcome after receiving the flu vaccination.***
- ***Please ***HONK THE HORN*** if you feel any shortness of breath, difficulty swallowing, sudden rash or any concern that you are having an allergic reaction to the flu shot***

DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS: (After you leave)

Call your local emergency number (911) if:

- Your mouth and throat are swollen.
- You are wheezing or have trouble breathing.
- You have chest pain or your heart is beating faster than normal for you.
- You have hives that spread over your body.
- You feel weak or dizzy.

Call your doctor if:

- You have increased pain, redness, or swelling around the area where the shot was given.
- You have questions or concerns about the flu shot.

Apply a warm compress to the injection area to decrease pain and swelling.

I declare that I feel my usual self and am able to leave the flu shot clinic. I have been checked by a medical personnel and feel comfortable to drive.
